## **GENERAL EDUCATION SESSION**



**Brent McClendon:** President and CEO of the National Wooden Pallet and Container Association will present information on the current state of the wooden pallet industry and will also discuss their work on the role of wood packaging in corporate sustainability discussions and carbon debates at the federal level.



**Beau Cotton:** McCoy Construction and Forestry, will present information on John Deere's newest mechanical harvesting equipment. McCoy has their equipment currently operating in Missouri and they will present information on the effectiveness of mechanical harvesting and processing in Missouri forests.



**Daniel Stark:** Program Manager with the Missouri Department of Labor On-site Safety and Health Consultation Program will discuss accident statistics in Missouri's forest products industry and present information on the On-site Safety and Health Consultation Program and the Safety and Health Achievement Recognition Program (SHARP). The presentation will include examples of current MFPA members involved in SHARP and how the program is implemented in Missouri.



**Dr. Benjamin Knapp:** University of Missouri professor of Silviculture will discuss the role of forest management in climate-smart forestry, including his research on carbon storage and carbon sequestration in Missouri's forest types and the potential role that solid wood products play in the carbon cycle.



**Richard Schwab:** President of Schwab Brothers Hydraulics and owner of M.A. Rigoni Inc., a 7-crew logging operation based out of North Florida, will present information on the effects the current economic crisis is having on our industry and innovative solutions his company, Schwab Brothers Hydraulics, is providing the forestry industry to combat the current economic crisis with their new Power Purchase Program that has been endorsed by the MFPA and their "in the field" hydraulic hose assembly system.





*Lt. Governor and gubernatorial candidate Mike Kehoe and Senator Karla Eslinger:* both will attend the education session and provide comments specific to the 2023 legislative session. Lt. Governor Kehoe will speak about his run for governor and how he intends to support the forest products industry in Missouri. MFPA has formally endorsed Kehoe for Governor.
