You are invited to bid on state-owned forest products described as follows: <u>Danville</u> <u>Conservation Area Timber Sale</u>

ACREAGE & LOCATION: The forest products are located on approximately 109 acres in Danville Conservation Area, managed by the Missouri Department of Conservation, located at Township 47 North, Range 06 West, Section 01 and Township 47 North, Range 05 West, Section 06 in Montgomery County, Missouri.

DESCRIPTION: There are three cutting blocks to be harvested within the sale unit. Across all cutting blocks, standing live timber that is marked with an orange paint slash at approximately six feet above the ground on two sides as well as at the base of the tree is for sale. Trees with a cull butt log, but merchantable top logs are marked with an orange " \overline{X} ". Trees marked with an "X" are considered non-merchantable and may be cut at the Buyer's discretion. All unmarked timber shall <u>**not**</u> be harvested.

Stands 5, 8, 18, and 37 are to be regenerated through a clearcut harvest, so all standing live timber is for sale in these stands. Volume estimates for all stands being regenerated are based on trees with a diameter at breast height greater than or equal to 12".

Block boundary trees (including Streamside Management Zone (SMZ) boundary trees) are marked with red paint at breast height or higher on the uphill side of the tree, however a boundary tree located at a corner of a block/SMZ is marked with three horizontal red stripes. <u>Boundary trees shall not be taken</u>.

Approximately 348,872 bd.ft. Doyle Tree Scale of mixed oak and hardwood sawtimber are available for harvest, as well as the cull trees. All forest products must be removed within <u>one year</u> of the signed contract. Volume details are on the following page.

before or on May 10, 2024 at 3:30pm CST. Plainly write <u>Danville Timber Sale</u> on the envelope containing your bid. <u>No acknowledgment of bids received will be sent for bids</u> received by mail.

A performance guarantee in the form of an "Irrevocable Letter of Credit" or other guarantee of performance made out to the Missouri Department of Conservation must be submitted at the time the contract is signed. The performance guarantee will be **in the amount of 10% of the Total Lump Sum Bid** and must be current for the entire length of the contract including any extensions. The contract is to be signed within ten working days following the awarding of the bid.

Non-mandatory tours of the sale area will be conducted on <u>Tuesday April 30, 2024</u>, and <u>Tuesday May 7, 2024</u>, both beginning at 10:00 a.m. Both sale tours will begin at the parking lot at the end of Route RB, immediately west of Stand 17 (see attached maps) within Danville Conservation Area. You <u>must</u> notify Bob Rives of your intention to attend the first tour by 4:00 p.m. on Friday April 26, 2024, or by 4:00 p.m. on Friday May 3, 2024 to attend the second tour by calling 573-815-7901 ext. 2964. The sale area is also open and accessible on foot for inspection on your own.

NOTE: "As of November 30, 2002, the Missouri Department of Conservation intends to sell forest products to companies and/or entities that have proper training. Accordingly, the Missouri Department of Conservation will only accept bids from and enter into contracts in which the individual who is designated to sign timber sale contracts <u>and</u> the individual responsible for supervision of the logging have both successfully completed training, and maintained certification, pursuant to the MFPA Professional Timber Harvester Training or its approved equivalent. Missouri Department of Conservation forest land is licensed in the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) program and supports program objectives."


Instructions

- 1. Category I. Enter the price per board foot for the specific species listed (preferred). Enter total lump sum bid (mandatory). By entering the price by specific species, you are improving the quality of the Missouri Timber Price Trends.
- 2. Category II. Enter whether or not a Master Logger will be overseeing the timber sale operations. If you entered "Yes" this Master Logger must remain on "Contract" during the entire operation. If the Master Logger listed is removed from the contract for any reason the Buyer has 21 days to replace them.
- 3. Category III. Within the last three years has any portion of a performance bond been withheld? Circle Yes or No. This applies only to the Buyer. **New Buyers** that have never worked on MDC lands cannot receive 10 pts for performance unless they provide 3 past logging job references that can be verified.
- 4. Category IV. Crews are awarded points based on the number of PTH loggers divided by the total number of crew members. For example a four person crew with three PTH loggers receives 10 points for a crew score of 75%. Because of this, it is mandatory to list all crew members that intend to work on this contract on the bid sheet, their certificate number if applicable and their job duty. We can only score by what you list at the time we receive the bid.


The process for adding or replacing crew members:

- Buyer can add as many PTH loggers to the crew as they want during the life of the contract.
- Buyer can only add a non-PTH logger if they remain within the range of points they received in this category. Using the example above add one non-PTH logger to the four person crew. Now the formula is three PTH divided by crew total of five for a crew score of 60%. Buyer would still be within the 10 point range.
- Buyer can claim points for a Master Logger in both Category II and Category IV. If points are awarded for both categories, the Master Logger **MUST** be onsite for the entire length of the contract.
- 5. To bid on a Missouri Department of Conservation timber sale the Buyer must be PTH trained or a Master Logger. The Buyer cannot claim points in Categories II and/or IV if the Buyer will not be serving in the role of Master Logger or one of the qualifying PTH positions. If the Buyer is also the log truck driver they cannot claim points as a PTH logger in Category IV. They would qualify only as a non-PTH crew member. Crew members listed should be onsite harvesting the sale throughout the duration of the contract.
- 6. No bid will be accepted unless signed and dated. No bid will be accepted if illegible. No late bids will be accepted.
- 7. No points will be awarded for spaces left blank.
- 8. The Missouri Department of Conservation does not engage in speculation or assumptions. Therefore we regard the Buyer as having true and legal authority to purchase the sale. All payments to the Missouri Department of Conservation must be made in the name of the Buyer.
