SOLICITATION OF BID FOR TIMBER

You are invited to bid on privately-owned timber described as follows: <u>Blake and Janet Crow</u> (Crow Land and Cattle) 1910 Broadway St. West Plains Mo., 65775, (417)293-9520.

ACREAGE & LOCATION: This sawtimber is located near the town of West Plains: Township 23 North, Range 8 West, Section 15 off St. Rt 17 to County Road 8470, all in Howell County, Missouri.

<u>DESCRIPTION</u> Approximately **96** acres of marked mixed hardwood timber, containing approximately **110,822 board feet** (International 1/4" Rule) of sawtimber have been marked for cutting. There are 1308 trees that were estimated to contain sawtimber volume in stands 1, 2, and 3 on the property (SEE ATTACHMENTS).

Neither the owner, or the Missouri Department of Conservation and its representatives will guarantee the accuracy of the volume quoted. Each prospective bidder should examine this timber and base bid on their own estimate of volume and acres. The Missouri Department of Conservation and any of its employees are not acting as a legal agent for the owner.

For harvest areas, the trees to be sold and cut are marked with a slash of blue paint at a point 4.5 feet above the ground and again at the base of the tree. Only trees containing merchantable saw timber volume were included in the above volume quotation. Hardwoods only 10" or greater were marked. The successful bidder may cut and remove any marked tree.

Cutting restrictions from bat guidelines will only allow timber harvesting from November 1st- March 31st. No timber shall be harvested from April 1st - October 31st.

Timber tour: The timber may be inspected during the week of July 17th- 21st by appointment only. For more information feel free to call the Department of Conservation, Resource Forester Tyler Trantham at the West Plains Regional Office at: (417) 256-7161 Ext. 4732.

<u>BID INSTRUCTIONS:</u> Only sealed, written, and legible bids will be accepted. <u>NO late, verbal or telephone bids will be accepted.</u> The contract will be awarded based on four bid evaluation categories. <u>The highest lump sum bid may not be awarded the contract.</u> Based on information provided, the landowners may select the successful bidder on factors other than price alone. Categories with missing information will receive zero points. Falsification of any part of this document will result in the rejection of the bid. <u>The landowner has the right to reject any and all bids regardless of points awarded or price offered.</u> Bids will be opened promptly on <u>Tuesday, July 25th, 2023 at 2:00 PM.</u>

Acceptable bids must be in a lump sum amount for all sale trees. Acceptable bids must also be <u>sealed</u> in an envelope clearly marked "<u>CROW TIMBER BID</u>". All bids must be returned to the West Plains Regional Office, 551 Joe Jones Blvd, West Plains, Missouri 65775 before 2:00 PM, Tuesday, July 25th, 2023.

<u>DO NOT ENCLOSE MONEY WITH BID.</u> The successful bidder will sign the contract and pay what is due within 30 days following the bid opening. Ten percent of the bid will be due at contract signing, with the balance due before any timber is cut. If desired, the sale can be paid for by cutting blocks designated by the Missouri Department of Conservation.

In addition, a performance deposit of 10% of the bid will be due at contract signing. The performance deposit will be held by the landowner until the satisfactory completion of the contract. If all contract requirements have been satisfied, the landowner will return the performance deposit to the successful bidder.

A sample contract will be available for inspection at the West Plains Regional Office. The successful bidder must have the timber cut and removed before March 31st, 2025. Extensions may be given due to weather and other factors. All saw timber not removed at that time shall revert back to the seller. All payments will be made to Blake & Janet Crow (Crow Land and Cattle).




