DESCRIPTION: (Species, volumes, unit of measurement, marked or otherwise designated, etc.) The entire harvest area has been "cut tree marked." Trees tallied and designated harvestable have been marked with an orange slash on one or both sides (but always the uphill side) and at the stump with orange paint. Trees that have significant defect have been marked with an X to indicate that they are free for harvest but were not included in the total tally. Additionally, some trees are marked with both an X and topped by a straight line to indicate that the butt log was considered a cull and thus was not included in the tally however upper logs were tallied as normal. All trees marked with orange paint are available for harvest. There are 1214 trees marked and tallied for approximately 88,388 bdft (international ¼" Scale).

*Timber condition is fair to good; the harvest is an overstory removal in areas that were harvested many years ago. The main objective is to remove the overstory in order to manage the advanced regeneration/small tree/small pole size trees for the future.

Based on information provided, the landowners may select the successful bidder on factors other than price alone. Categories with missing information will receive zero points. Falsification of any part of this document will result in the rejection of the bid. **The landowner has the right to reject any and all bids regardless of points awarded or price offered.** Bids will be opened promptly on <u>November 4th 2023 at</u> <u>3:00PM.</u> The contract will be awarded within ten business days following the bid opening. When all contract requirements have been satisfied, the landowner will return the performance bond to the successful bidder. **The performance bond must be current for the entire length of the contract including any extensions**. 


