


GOVERNOR PARSON SIGNS FOREST PRODUCTS PROMOTION BILL

On Tuesday, August 29,2023 Governor Parson, Senator Karla Eslinger, Representative Hannah Kelly, and many other elected officials and distinguished guests, gathered at Royal Oak in West Plains for a ceremonial signing of SB 138, which establishes a promotion fund for Missouri forest products. Jim Bennett, CEO of Royal Oak, and many other staff members from the company did an outstanding job hosting the event and created a great backdrop for the Governor to sign a bill that will help all sectors of the industry in Missouri. SB 138, which was led by Senator Eslinger and Rep. Kelly, establishes the opportunity in statute for the General Assembly to dedicate funding for promoting Missouri forest products for the next five years. The program is established in the Department of Economic Development (DED), and they will partner with MFPA to implement the program. "For the first time in our history, MFPA will have the opportunity to establish and fund a program that will be specifically designed to inform citizens on how forest products, and the industries that make them, provide social benefits that we all depend on but rarely speak about or even recognize. We will distribute information to the public that will hopefully make them think about the importance of their purchase choices when they are considering wood versus non-renewable and non-sustainable alternatives such as plastic, concrete, and iron. The forest products industry drives the forest management process, that is a fact that very few members of the public understand. We plan to use this opportunity provided by the taxpayers to get the word out on all the great things that the forest products industry provides to society and we hope that it will mean more forests get managed and consumers use more wood. After all Wood Is Super Cool!", said Executive Director Brian Brookshire. The details of the grant are currently being developed by DED and we hope that the project will be launched by the first of the year.

MFPA has two lists on our website that we encourage land owners to contact when asking about hiring a logger. One list is the Missouri Master Logger List, and the other list is the PTH Trained Logger List. Not only is PTH smart training, it's a great advertising tool. After getting your PTH Certification, you will need one Continuing Education Credit. Not 5, or 10, or more like other states...just one. Of course, there are a lot of ways to get that credit. You can go to our website, www. moforest.org, and complete one of the online training modules. You can also attend an industry related training session or meeting. One up-and-coming opportunity is Missouri Logging Council Area Meetings. These meetings are a way to keep up with area activities. 
